

**4<sup>th</sup> National Summit on Good and Replicable Practices and

(6<sup>th</sup> July 2017 – 08<sup>th</sup> July 2017)**

The **4<sup>th</sup> National Summit on Good and Replicable Practices and Innovations in Public Healthcare Systems** organized by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (MoHFW) from **6<sup>th</sup> July 2017 – 08<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at Indore**, Madhya Pradesh to capture and share the best practices and innovations at various levels of health services delivery under National Health Mission. The summit was attended by officials of MoHFW who are involved in providing technical support to states, various State Health Officials who shared their experiences, various Development Partners and other stakeholders who contribute to implementation of best practices.
